Andrew E. Hill was born in 1920 to dentist Dr. Charles E. and Ruth Roquemore Hill in Shreveport, Louisiana. His maternal grandparents were Dr. A.J. and Ida Roquemore. Abandoned by his father, an alcoholic, in 1924 he and his mother lived with the Roquemores and he graduated Byrd High School in 1937. A Lieutenant in World War II he was honorably discharged for a nervous condition and was never able to return to a normal life. These letters to his mother in Shreveport from California chronicles his attempts to seek relief from his problems.
